



Conservation Measures and Resolutions adopted at the Thirty-First Meeting of CCAMLR

TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION
AND THE SCIENTIFIC COMMITTEE

Members are notified of the following revisions to the CCAMLR conservation measures and resolutions which were adopted by the Commission at the Thirty-First Annual Meeting (CCAMLR-XXXI, Section 7). The date for notification for the purposes of Article IX.6 of the Convention is 7 November 2012.
