


Figure 1: Planned locations of fishing stations around Elephant Island and the South Shetland Islands in March/April 2012




Figure 2: Planned locations of fishing stations in a box west of Elephant Island in March/April 2012




Figure 3: Planned locations of fishing stations north of the Antarctic Peninsula in March/April 2012
