NOTIFICATION OF RESEARCH VESSEL ACTIVITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF CONSERVATION MEASURE 24-01

Name and registration number of vessel: Sil, 73045

Division and subarea in which research is to be carried out: 48.3

Estimated dates of entering and leaving CCAMLR Convention Area: 10th – 31st January 2009

Purpose of research is:

- To determine the icefish standing stock to produce an assessment of icefish stock size for the derivation of a Total Allowable Catch (TAC), and for investigations into icefish population structure and management;
- To determine toothfish pre-recruitment population structure to contribute to the estimates of sustainable yield and assessments of the status of the toothfish stock;
- To carry out deepwater trawls (500m – 1250m) to provide information on the abundance and ecology of grenadier species; and
- To determine the standing stock of other major demersal fish species in the area such as *Chaenocephalus aceratus* and *Nototothenia rossi*;

Fishing equipment likely to be used: Bottom trawl
