The Marine Stewardship Council (MSC) is an international non-profit organisation which works in partnership with a wide range of stakeholders in the seafood industry, including fishers, processors, retailers, consumers, governments, non- and inter-governmental organisations and regional fisheries management organisations to promote sustainability in this sector. Our mission is to use our ecolabel and fishery certification programme to contribute to the health of the world's oceans by recognising and rewarding sustainable fishing practises, influencing the choices people make when buying seafood, and working with our partners to transform the seafood market to a sustainable basis.

We have been working with a number of fisheries in the CCAMLR region and have an interest in the regional management of these resources. We feel that our participation at future meetings could be of benefit to CCAMLR Members interested in learning more about our certification and ecolabelling programme.
