#### Marine Debris and its Impact on Marine Living Resources in Antarctic Waters – Submission of Data

Members are reminded of the requirement to submit data from surveys of (i) beached marine debris, (ii) entanglement of marine mammals in marine debris, (iii) marine debris associated with seabird colonies, and (iv) seabirds and marine mammals soiled with hydrocarbons.

All outstanding current and retrospective data from these surveys should now be submitted to the Secretariat. A summary of marine debris data submitted by Members and currently held in the database is attached for reference purposes.

Members are reminded that only data collected in accordance with the standard forms and instructions adopted at CCAMLR-XX will be accepted by the Secretariat and entered into the marine debris database. All forms and instructions are available on the CCAMLR website (Scientific Committee > Marine Debris > Standard forms, methods and instructions).

Only data submitted by the deadline of 1 August 2003 will be entered into the database and used by the Secretariat for the preparation of its annual report on the status and trends shown in the data reported from marine debris surveys.

Members who conduct standardised quantitative surveys from vessels of debris at sea are invited to advise the Secretariat of such surveys, their design and the data collected.
